



Their work was recognized in regional, national, or international publications or articles, and is current










Many recognized architects were born in the Global South but not practicing there

East Asia is seeing a growing amount of female architects that are being recognized for their work


Many award winning architects are being recognized in Mexico and South America but there is less information about Central America
